Over 400 participants entered this year and lined up on the famous Folkestone Leas promenade on Sunday for the start of the popular 17<sup>th</sup> half marathon.

I was pleased to see once again so many newcomers to the event from as far afield as Bedford. A few 17-year-olds came on board and one runner at 75 who beat a few much younger!
