### 20<sup>TH</sup> FOLKESTONE ROTARY HALF MARATHON

*Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> September 2025*

Folkestone, Kent – 29<sup>th</sup> September 2025

**Forward comment from Race Director Ray Johnson:**

"Sunday saw the long-awaited Folkestone Half Marathon return for 2025 in its 20<sup>th</sup> year, setting Folkestone alight with race day vibes and finish line smiles in the autumnal sunshine. With a sellout crowd of over 800 entries, the race enjoyed a record year and The Leas was bursting with runners, supporters and charity groups flocking to take part in this magnificent community event.

It's not just the stunning seafront route and electric atmosphere that makes this race such a calendar highlight. The Folkestone Half Marathon benefits from the support of local groups such as The Cadets and has raised over £750,000 for charities in the area since it first began. It's an event with community at its heart supported by the very same at every level of organisation.

This year saw funds raised for The Sports Trust who achieve some fantastic outcomes. As a not-for-profit charity they dismantle barriers to sport participation.

With the Road of Remembrance still inaccessible, the Half Marathon entertained once again a different route for 2025, but our runners remained undeterred, still braving the distance to cross the finish line. They were cheered on by crowds of spectators who came to lend support to their valiant efforts and join the race day celebrations.

First place male was taken by Wagahata Zereom who flew across the finish line in 01:11:22. First female was awarded to Alice Tidswell who completed her Half Marathon in an incredible 01:30:22. Folkestone Running & Athletics Club proudly took away the first team prizes in both the male and female categories. It was a splendid day of racing enjoyed by all.

We look forward to welcoming back our triumphant runners to The Folkestone Coastal 10k next May and, of course, back to The Folkestone Half Marathon in 2026!"

Help was received with sincere thanks from over 100 marshals and assistants including Hythe, Channel & Folkestone Rotary Clubs, Nice Work and many local support volunteers including the Police Cadets. I would also like to thank our many sponsors including Alcaline Transport, KAP Group, Folkestone & Hythe Catering Association & McDonalds. Our thanks also to Folkestone & Hythe District Council, NHS and Riviera Residents Ltd for their valuable support. A special mention to Christpher Finn-Kelcey our eldest participant of 80 years with a commendable time of 2:27:00 who also raised vital funds for the Guide Dogs for the Blind.

Once again, we have received tremendous feedback from the runners congratulating us for such a great event, by way of organisation, encouragement from marshals and most importantly holding the event safely particularly with a new route due to the Road of Remembrance hill being closed.”
